supports patient care, bio-medical research, new medical technologies and advanced medical-related activities.



Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum

The Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum offers unique venues that will make your event truly memorable.

With Lincoln's log cabin on one side and the White House on the other, the museum's main Plaza provides a majestic backdrop for wedding receptions, awards dinners or cocktail parties. Its 4,500 square feet can accommodate an elegant 300-person dinner or reception for up to 450 people. You can even make arrangements for guests to experience the Museum's breathtaking exhibits and theaters.

The library building features both the soaring Lincoln Atrium, an elegant space for a 100-person seated dinner or reception for up to 250 people, and the Lincoln Reception Room, a three-story glass rotunda (inscribed with a quote from the Gettysburg Address!) that accommodates up to 60 people for meals and receptions.

If you need meeting space, our state-of-the-art Multi-Purpose Room seats up to 300 people and offers satellite uplink, tele-conferencing, video conferencing and full broadcast capabilities. It also has a gallery space available for receptions. For small group meetings consider the Governor's Conference Room. It features a large conference table with 20 comfortable chairs and a wall of windows that make a terrific location for your next brainstorming session.











Old State Capitol

The Old State Capitol is a reconstruction of Illinois' fifth statehouse, the first to be located in Springfield. It is here that Lincoln practiced law, served as a legislator and gave his famed House Divided speech on slavery in 1858. The building served as the seat of state government and a center of Illinois political life from 1839-1876.

The Old State Capitol is an elegant setting for candlelight receptions. There is something special about this building in the evening - it is easy to transport yourself back in time and imagine what it must have been like for citizens of Springfield in the mid-1800s.





Dana-Thomas House

Perhaps the most complete of all early Frank Lloyd Wright dwellings, it was never significantly altered and has over 100 pieces of original Wright-designed oak furniture, 250 examples of art glass light fixtures and lamps. The barrel-vaulted dining room and gallery/ballroom are two of the most photographed spaces in the history of American architecture.

The Dana-Thomas House, one of the finest examples of Prairie Style architecture designed by Frank Lloyd Wright, is located in the heart of Springfield. Originally built for local socialite and activist Susan Lawrence Dana at the turn of the century, this lavish residence is now open to the public and available for private functions.









Ace Sign Museum

The Ace Sign Co. Museum includes over 85 historic signs from Springfield and Route 66.

The museum features a number of notable signs including a 12' tall 1953 Neon Pepsi Bottle Cap, a sign that once identified the Train Depot where Lincoln gave his farewell speech, and a number of other vintage signs originating from memorable dining establishments & vintage brewing companies. The wooden barreled ceilings bring a modern feel to the space and the open floor plan allows for a flexible event layout.





Hoogland Center for the Arts

This former Masonic Temple underwent a \$9 million renovation to completely transform the 80,000 sq. ft. facility into *The Hoogland Center*, one of the most unique and elegant spaces in the Springfield area.

Located in the heart of historic downtown, *The Hoogland Center for the Arts* is a state-of-the-art facility that hosts events throughout the year from business meetings to black-tie affairs. Home to 20 resident organizations, the Hoogland has facility space for small board meetings in their Social Room all the way up to seating 160 for dinner. In addition, they have an on-site caterer that can prepare everything from a simple continental breakfast to a world-class dinner with full bar service, making the Hoogland an ideal location for presentations, cocktail parties or wedding receptions.
