Welcome to the Springfield Parks – they are open at dawn and close at 10:30pm. Exceptions are Riverside, Carpenter, Enos, Gehrmann or Gurgens Parks that open at dawn and close at dusk.

We encourage you to unplug, have **FUN** playing in the green spaces, stop to smell the flowers, go “birding,” pause life on our benches... and remember to:

- Leash and clean-up after your pets.
- Leave your alcohol at home.
- Follow safe speeds while driving through the parks along-side other pedestrians.
- Park in designated areas.
- Build fires in proper receptacles, only where designated.
- Obtain a park permit for groups of 25 or more (see page 88 for details).
- Follow park hours.

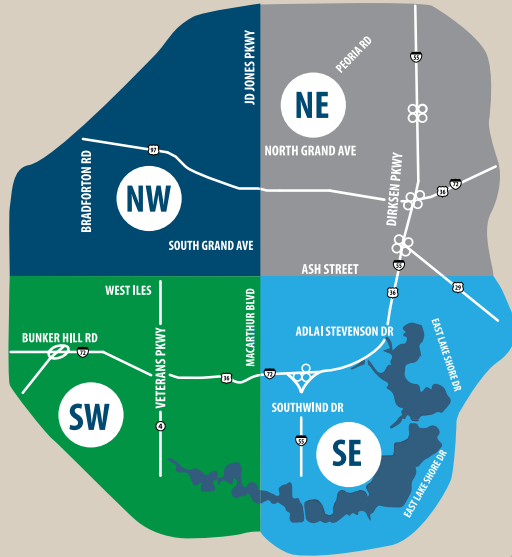

Our Mission

The Springfield Park District is committed to providing accessible and memorable recreational opportunities that enrich the community and improve the quality of life for generations as well as conserve our natural resources.

Park Rules to Remember

- Be courteous of others sharing your parks
- Supervise children at all times
- Playgrounds are **"Kid Friendly Zones"** where smoking is discouraged
- Leave nature as you found it for others to enjoy & dispose of litter in proper receptacles
- Vehicles watch your speed, stopping and signaling when driving around park zones
- Vehicles left after park closing will be towed at owner's expense

Alcohol

Carry-in alcoholic beverages are prohibited in parks and facilities.

Code of Conduct

All park goers, facility patrons, and persons permitting park space for private events must adhere to the Springfield Park District's Code of Conduct. For a complete list of this code, click SPD Forms on our website.

Concealed Carry

Firearms are not allowed in Park District facilities or on Park District properties.

Parking

Drivers must use designated parking areas. However, if parking area is full, drivers are permitted to park along park district surface streets so long as at least two wheels remain on the paved street at all times.

Always be sure to lock your vehicle while in the park and keep your valuables stowed safely out of site!

General Facilities Rules

All facilities participants are expected to follow the rules of the facilities. Specialty areas of the facilities have posted signs stating special rules specific to that area. Disregard or abuse of facility rules may result in removal by staff or police from the facility for a designated length of time or permanently.

Fishing

Through a partnership with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources, many of our ponds are stocked with bass and bluegill. Each year before the spring trout season, the Washington Park Upper Pond and the Southwind Park Pond are stocked with Rainbow Trout. A fishing license is required to fish in the State of Illinois. Additionally, an inland trout stamp is required to fish for trout.

Dogs

Dogs must remain on a leash at all times. Owners must pick up after their dog.

Park Closing Policy

All Park District parks open at dawn and close at 10:30pm. This does not include the parks of Riverside, Carpenter, Enos, Gehrmann or Gurgens Park that open at dawn and close at dusk.

Park District Waiver

A Waiver and Release of All Claims form must be signed when registering yourself or your minor child for Springfield Park District programs and/or memberships. Registration waivers are available at all Park District facilities or online at springfieldparks.org.

Warning of Risk

Recreational activities/programs are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental, and emotional resources of each participant. SPECIAL EVENTS OR WALK/RUNS

Organizers who plan a special event on Park District property must get written approval from the Park District prior to the event. Permit fees will apply to events that generate revenue on park property.

Charity walks/runs can help organizations raise significant funds by leveraging people's desire to help others while filling their basic need to get in shape. The Park District makes it easy for organizers to host a walk in Washington, Lincoln and Southwind Parks.

WALK PACKAGES INCLUDE:

- United State Track and Field Certified race courses (2 mile and 5K) *excluding Southwind Park
- Marked courses with and accompanying race course map
- Barricades for large walks to prevent vehicular traffic (not available in Lincoln Park)
- Exclusive use of the picnic shelter during the event (by the playground)

RESERVATION INFORMATION

Reservations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis for the season beginning on the first working day in March for groups of 15 or more.

Shelters may be reserved from May 1 through October, weather permitting. (Permission is not required for groups under 25, however, there is no guarantee that the restrooms will be open and that space and tables will be available.)

A minimum of 7 days advance notice is required for all reservations. All documents and payment of fees are due at the time the reservation is made.

PERMITS

Picnic shelter permits give the holder exclusive use of the picnic shelter for which the permit has been issued on the date specified. All other facilities are open to the public.

Picnic shelter permits include use of the shelter and the existing set of tables, trash cans, grill(s) and facilities of the shelter. Additional tables and trash cans can be requested, if available, for an additional fee. Groups are encouraged to familiarize themselves with the available facilities and rules of use prior to filling out a picnic shelter reservation request form either in person or online at **springfieldparksFUN.org**

Groups that violate policies, fail to properly clean up their site, cause damage to facilities, are larger than arranged for, or are misleading in their application are subject to damage assessment and additional fees may be assigned.

PICNIC PERMIT RULES:

Reservation forms will be posted on-site at the permitted picnic location by Park District Maintenance. Permittee must carry reservation forms on their person at all times during the date of the event.

Cooking is allowed on supplied barbecue grills only. Hot coals must be extinguished and removed from the area, unless a container is provided on site. **OPEN FIRES ARE NOT ALLOWED!**

Groups are responsible for placing all trash in the trash cans provided or properly removing it from the site. The site will be inspected after each use. Any excess debris or damage will be the responsibility of the permit holder.

If barricades are requested, it is the permit holders responsibility to set up and take down barricades (provided by park district) for event.

Vehicles are only permitted on designated roads and parking areas throughout the parks.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED INCLUDE, but are not limited to: tents or shade canopies larger than 10 x 10, bands, disc jockeys, generators for electricity, portable bathrooms, commercial uses or productions, circus acts, public displays regardless of being profit or non-profit, use of propane and/or charcoal grills, food vendors, alcohol, fireworks, bounce houses, water features such as "slip-n-slides" are prohibited - unless special permit for any of these items has been issued.
